

Lyng CE Primary School is committed to ensuring equality of provision throughout the school community.

To achieve this, our equality objectives for 2017-18 are as follows:

- To enable all pupils to reach the highest level of personal achievement by raising attainment for disadvantaged (Pupil Premium) pupils who are also high prior attainers.
- To enable school staff to understand the needs of pupils and the approaches used in the school to support children identified with disabilities by providing training (eg autism) The Disability Discrimination Act 2005 DDA defines a disabled person as someone who has 'a physical or mental impairment which has a substantial or long-term effect on his or her ability to carry out normal day-to-day activities.' (Physical impairments include vision and hearing difficulties, asthma, eczema, ADHD, ASD, cancer and multiple sclerosis).
- To promote positive attitudes and respect towards others, other beliefs, faiths and religions, ethnic origins, abilities and disabilities, backgrounds and ways of life through:
experiences within the curriculum
ensuring school environment, displays and resources reflect diversity (faith, religions, ethnic origins, abilities and disabilities, backgrounds and ways of life.
- provide improved disability access with appropriate resources to support pupils with particular needs (eg sensory)
