

In Mathematics we are focussing on using place value for addition, subtraction and problems involving money. We will learn about angles and the properties of shapes.

As Scientists we are learning about balanced and unbalanced forces, gravity and friction. Then we will learn about magnetism: when magnets attract, or repel and which materials are magnetic. We will also learn about Light and how it travels and reflects.

As writers we will be planning and writing poems, fantasy stories and instructions based on our topic: Local Study.
We will be practising our spelling and grammar using a variety of written activities.

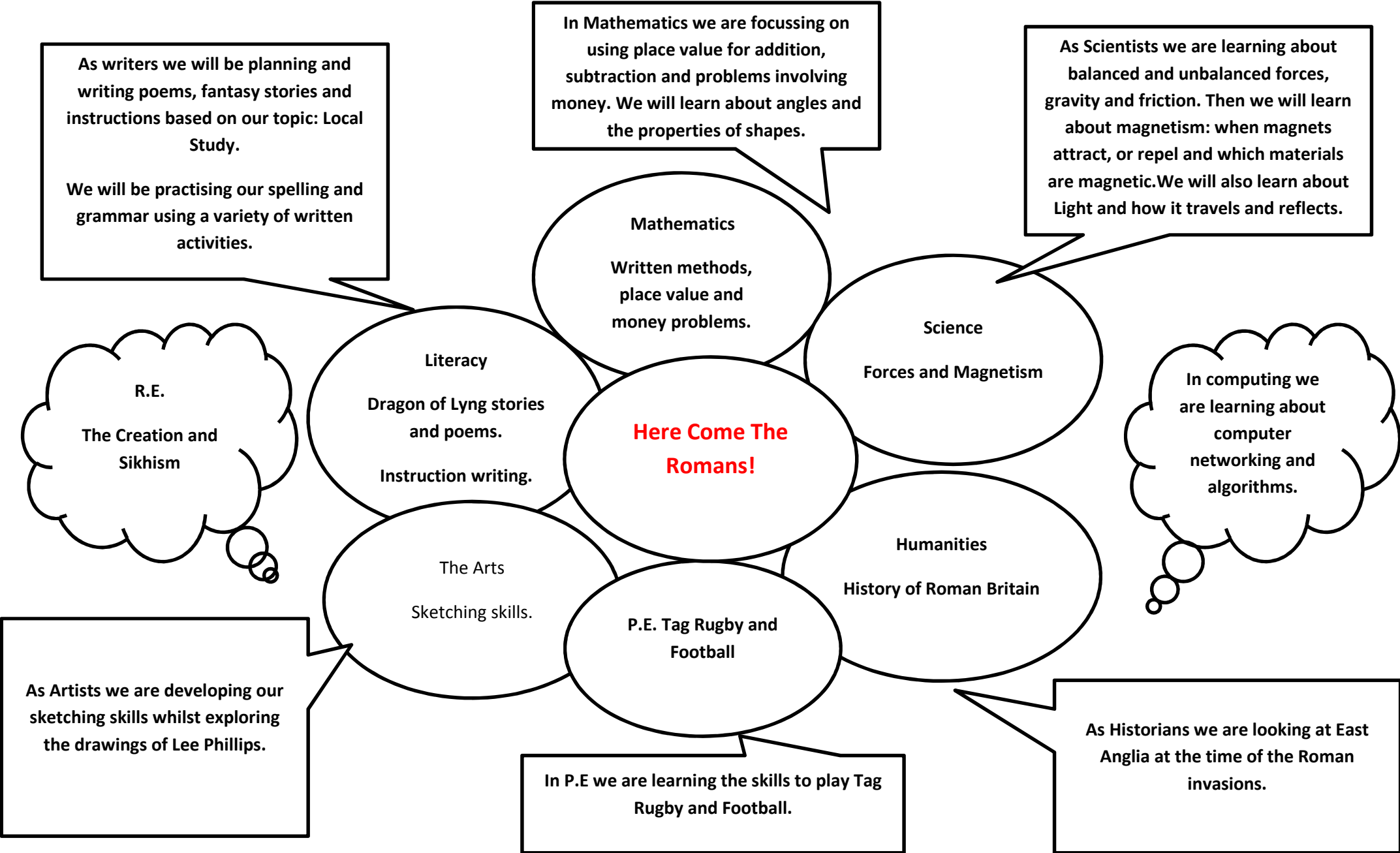
