The class teacher will collect homework from the children every Monday. There will be a spelling test every Monday.

### **Other ways to help at home.**

Please read regularly with your child signing and /or adding a comment in his/her reading log. Short frequent reading times are better than 1 long one each week.

Practise times tables, starting with 2,5,10 then 3,4 then 6,7,8,9.- children should learn to recall these quickly.

### **PE and Music**

Drumming lessons with Mr Hodson continue this half term. Children are learning to play different rhythms, and play together as a group
