Physical Development

In whole class focus sessions and weekly PE sessions we will learn about:

- People who help us
- Negotiating obstacles
- Developing co-ordination with aiming and target games



How you can help with your child's learning at home:

Understanding the World: Point out examples of technology in your homes, and what they are used for. Point out and talk about the different vehicles and landmarks you can spot when you are out and about!

Maths: Talk about and involve your child in reading price tickets and when using coins to pay for things.

Literacy: Point out different methods of communication you notice from day to day; letters, postcards, emails etc. Please also continue to remind and support your child in correct pencil hold and letter formation.

Please also continue to familiarise yourselves with your child's 'Learning Goals' by having a look at the classroom wall display, and please do let us know when you have noticed your child making steps towards these goals outside of school!
