

How you can help with your child's learning at home:

Over the next week or so, the children will be given individual reading books and reading records to take home and practise sharing stories and talking about pictures. Please record the dates, and comments about your children's reading in the green reading record when you have shared a book with your child so that we know when to change the books around.

The children will also soon be visiting the school library on a fortnightly basis to borrow a book. Please ensure these books are kept in the book bags after reading so that they are there and ready to be swapped over the next week!
