Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to the start of an exciting year in Rowan Class, I am already looking forward to the year ahead.

We are starting the autumn term with a new topic based around becoming Archaeologist to develop our understanding of the period from the Stone Age to the Vikings. During the first half term we will base our topic and literacy work around Stone Age to the Romans. Literacy will focus on studying a range of texts from stories with a historical setting to instructions all the way to poems. In science we will focus on Rocks and Soils especially considering the Roman's use of marble. We will enjoy making a class display of all we get up to as well as trying out many traditional crafts from cave paintings to mosaic.
