

Our topic is 'Explorers of Lyng' We will be looking at the village of Lyng and understanding the main differences between a village, town and city. Children will have the opportunity to explore Lyng and understand the characteristics of a village. You can help your child with the topic by looking at maps, and finding familiar places, as well as by talking about places you have visited and their features eg is there a school, church, factory, park, farm, garage, shops? What is close by ... a motorway, woods, fields?

After half term we will move on to Exploring Kenya.
