

As readers we will be reading a selection of fiction and non-fiction books during our shared reading sessions. We will be writing for a range of purposes this half term including writing our own set of instructions. Children will begin to write sentences in chronological order and Year 2 will be including a variety of conjunctions and a range of adjectives in their writing.

We will be studying the art work by 'Giuseppe Archimboldo'. Children will look at his style of work and begin to create their own art working involving sketching, painting and printing.

As scientists we will be looking at the 4 seasons and the weathers which occur in the season. We will also be taking daily weather forecasts to see how the weather changes as we move across seasons.

As mathematicians we will be looking at the place value of numbers YR1 (up to 20) YR 2 (up to 100). We will be counting both forwards and backwards from a given number and partitioning numbers into tens and ones. As we progress through the Autumn term we will begin to use our number knowledge to solve addition and subtraction problems.

In PE we will be developing a range P.E. skills and ball skills.

As Geographers we will be looking at where our food comes from and the processes which happen to our food in order for us to buy it at the shops. We will be looking a range of fruit and vegetables and where they are grown.

Our topic is 'Field to plate' We will be exploring different aspects of how our food is grown including: fruit and vegetables, wheat, maize, tractors, and scarecrows. We will also be linking this in with the Harvest Festival.

Dear Parents and Carers

It has been so lovely to welcome everybody back to school after the summer holidays! It has been so lovely for Mrs Lemon and myself to see the Willow children getting to know each other and trying their hardest in their new year groups!

This half term we have a very exciting topic- the children have already shown such great enthusiasm!

This year we are using a new phonics programme 'Success for All'. All children will bring home 2 reading books per week (1 shared reader they will be familiar with in class and 1 shared reader which is phonetically decodable) More information will follow about this in due course. Please ensure you are reading with your child **at least** 3 times a week and their reading record is signed, and is in school every day. Just a polite reminder, children can arrive at 8:45 and the register is at 8:55. It is important children arrive to school on time to maximise learning opportunities and to ensure they do not miss phonics.
