Maths	Monday	Look at a calendar. Discuss today's date. Think about the day of the week and the month of the year. Can you remember our song for days of the week and months of the year? Use the words <b>tomorrow and yesterday</b> e.g. If it is Monday today what day will it be tomorrow? Listen to Monday's song <u>https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/curations/days-of-the-week</u>
	Tuesday	Recap days of the week and months of the year. Listen to Tuesday's song <u>https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/curations/days-of-the-week</u> Watch <u>https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zhk82hv/articles/zydsb82</u> Talk about your day. Sequence the order of your activities throughout the day e.g. get up, have breakfast, clean teeth right through to bedtime. Use the words associated with time e.g. <b>before</b> , <b>after</b> . You may like to do the Bitesize activity which follows the video.
	Wednesday	Recap days of the week and months of the year. Listen to Wednesday's song <u>https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/curations/days-of-the-week</u> Learn how to read the time to <b>o'clock</b> on a clock with hands (analogue). Now look at it on a digital clock. Additional challenge: Can you solve problems involving o'clock? E.g. If it is 6 o'clock now, what time will it be in 2 hours? If it is 8 o'clock now what was the time 3 hours ago?
	Thursday	Recap days of the week and months of the year. Listen to Thursday's song <u>https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/curations/days-of-the-week</u> watch <u>https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zhk82hv/articles/zcmdwxs</u> Learn how to read the time to <b>half past</b> on a clock with hands (analogue). Now look at it on a digital clock. <i>Additional challenge: Can you solve problems involving half past? E.g. If it is half past 7 now, what time will it be in</i> <i>half an hour? If it is 8.30 now what was the time one hour ago?</i>
	Friday	Recap days of the week and months of the year. Listen to Friday's song <u>https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/curations/days-of-the-week</u> Show your understanding of <b>o'clock and half past</b> by filling in sheets if you can - search Year 1 Tell the Time Differentiated Worksheets If you don't have access to a printer look at the time throughout the day and discuss whether it is o'clock or half past.

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English **Please also encourage your child to read daily	Monday	How many different traditional stories can you think of? Now write a list, e.g. Little Red Riding Hood, Goldilocks and the Three Bears. Work together if this is tricky by taking it in turns to write. <i>Challenge: Can you list at least 6</i> ?
	Tuesday	Read The Three Billy Goats Gruff (download the PowerPoint from Twinkl Home learning Hub) or listen to the story online. Or you could work together to tell the story from memory.
	Wednesday	Retell the story together. Can you add voices to represent the characters? Have fun! Sequence the story by creating a story board -draw 6 pictures which tell the story in the right order. Keep this for Thursday.
	Thursday	Write a sentence for the first 3 pictures. Challenge: add detail to your sentences such as adding an adjective e.g. the little Billy Goat Gruff went over the <mark>grey</mark> bridge to get to the <mark>lush, green</mark> grass on the other side.
	Friday	Write a sentence for the last 3 pictures. Remember to use the sounds you know.
Phonics	Monday	How many words can you think of which have any "ai" sound (this could be spelt in different ways) e.g snail, tray, gate. Write each word on a separate piece of paper (you may need adult guidance to spell correctly). Now sort them into different piles. What do you notice? (that there are many different ways to make the "ai" sound) NB these sounds containing 2 letters are called <b>digraphs</b> . <u>Keep the word cards for rest of week</u> .
	Tuesday	Select the cards which have the <b>ai</b> sound. What do you notice i.e the <b>ai</b> sound is in the middle of the word). Can you read these words? <b>snail trail train brain chain</b> Choose 2 of the words and write a sentence.
	Wednesday	Select the cards which have the <b>ay</b> sound. What do you notice? (the <b>ay</b> sound is at the end of the word). Watch <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=YZg3fV5x8a8</u> Which word doesn't fit the pattern? Can you write these words? <b>tray pray spray</b>
	Thursday	Select the cards which have the <b>a</b> - <b>e</b> sound. What do you notice? (the <b>a</b> is in the middle and the <b>e</b> is at the end of the word- this is called a <b>split digraph</b> )




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
