Things have been very different this year, so we haven't had the chance to do our usual move up days, to introduce you to Oak class.

Year 5's, you will remember what Oak class is like, although it probably feels like a very long time since you have been in the classroom.

I have put together some questions and answers of things you might like to know before you return in September (Year 6 helped me do this, as we are in school, at the moment):

### **What do I need to bring to school?**

Miss Wharton will provide you with everything you need for learning. You should not bring your own pencil case or other equipment to school at the moment. You will also need your packed lunch (if you're not having a school one), your coat, water bottle and P.E kit to stay in school all week (it can be taken home at the weekends to wash). ### **Where will I sit?**

Our topic when we return, in September is World War II, We will learn about what happened to ordinary people and children during the war. We will learn about the home front, the rationing, digging for victory, 'make do and mend', Dad's Army, the Land girls and the role of women during the war, the Blitz and the experience of evacuee children. We will try to understand about use of propaganda and censorship; design war posters, identity papers, ration books and role-play home front scenarios.

It is a really interesting topic which I'm sure you'll enjoy.
