Can I solve problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division and a combination of these, including understanding the meaning of the equals sign?

Each week Miss Wharton will tell you an activity you can practice at home to embed your maths skills. Remember practice is the key to embedding our learning.

Keep revising all your times tables and related division facts up to 12.

What might happen in this story?

At the end of the book:

Would you change any part of the story? How?

Would you change any of the characters? How?

Which part of the story was the funniest, scariest, saddest and happiest?
