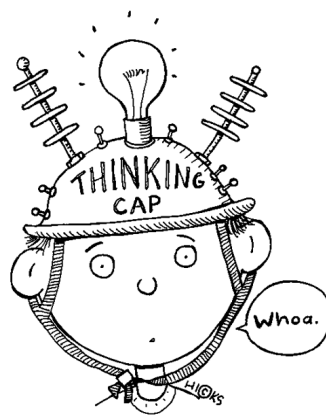

Choose pairs of fractions to add together. Use each fraction once.

$\frac{4}{5}$	$\frac{30}{100}$	$\frac{8}{10}$	$\frac{9}{15}$
$\frac{10}{20}$	$\frac{7}{10}$	$\frac{45}{50}$	$\frac{18}{20}$

Can you find the total of all the fractions?

Identify the missing numbers in these fraction calculations:

$$\frac{5}{6} + \frac{4}{6} = \frac{9}{6} = \frac{\square}{\square}$$
$$\frac{4}{12} + \frac{11}{12} = \frac{\square}{\square} = \frac{\square}{\square}$$
$$1 \frac{5}{8} - \frac{6}{8} = \frac{\square}{8}$$

Which part of the story was the funniest, saddest, scariest, saddest and happiest?

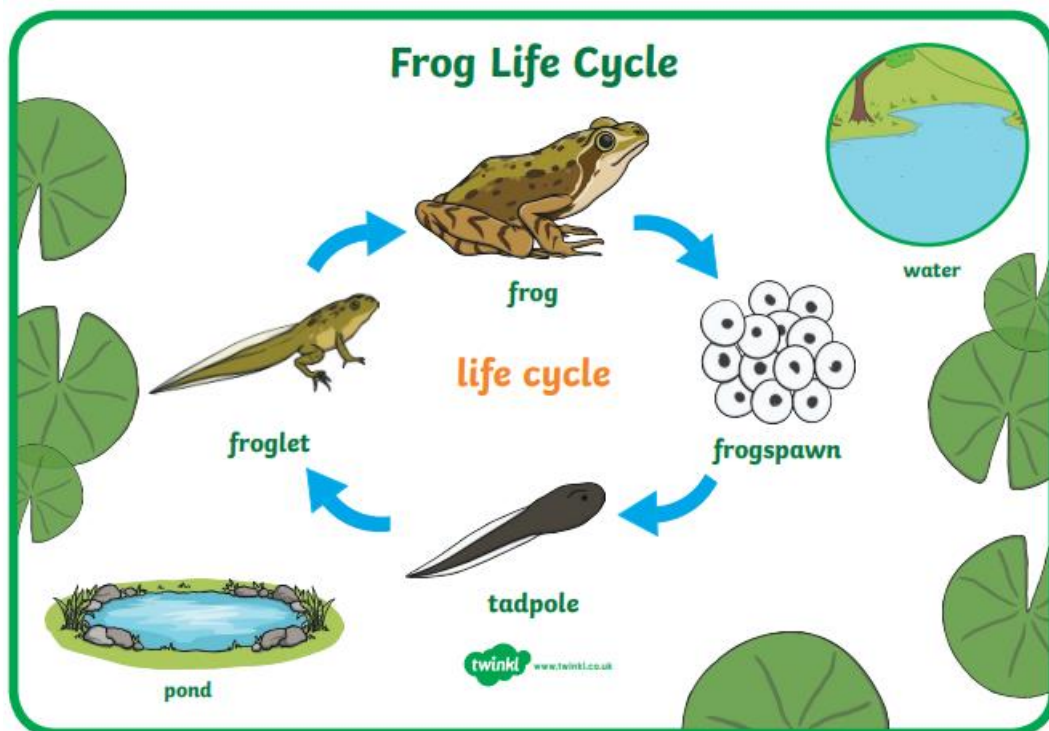
## Half termly Homework:
