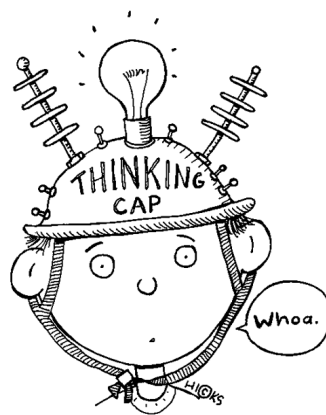

### Converting Fractions

Mixed Numbers to Improper Fractions

$2\frac{2}{6} = \frac{6}{6} + \frac{6}{6} + \frac{6}{6} = \frac{14}{6}$

Multiplication Method  
 $2 \times 6 + 2 = 14$  (sixths)  
 $\frac{14}{6}$

Can you convert these improper fractions into mixed number fractions?

$\frac{3}{2}$	$\frac{4}{3}$	$\frac{5}{4}$	$\frac{6}{5}$	$\frac{7}{6}$	$\frac{11}{8}$
$\frac{16}{8}$	$\frac{5}{2}$	$\frac{8}{3}$	$\frac{11}{4}$	$\frac{12}{5}$	$\frac{14}{6}$

Would you change any of the characters? How?

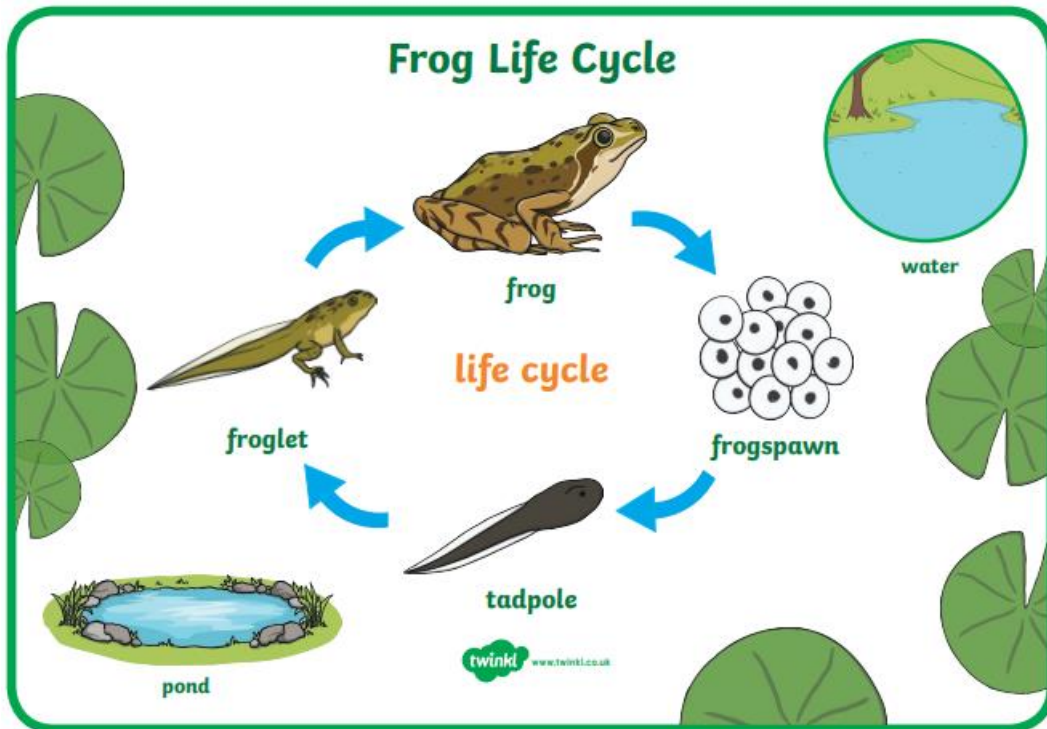
## Half termly Homework:
