### Fine motor activity

Use the sheet below to make your own Mr. Potato Head character. Cut out the potato man, and then cut out any accessories you want to give him!

### Maths

#### Resources needed:

- Multilink cubes(or lego/bricks)
- Paper/whiteboard

**Starter:** Describe a 3D shape and ask your child to guess which one you are describing. This will help refresh their memory of the 3D shape work they did before half term!

**Activity:** Use multilink cubes to make a tower of 10. If you don't have multilink cubes at home, you can use lego or bricks.

Ask your child to come and check how many cubes are in the tower to confirm there are 10. Ask them to break the tower into 2 towers. Ask them to say how many are in each tower as adult writes the number sentence. Say the number sentence out loud e.g 4 add 6 equals ten. Ask your child to repeat this number sentence back to you. Repeat this, and when the children have got the hang of it, ask your child to make the 2 towers give it a go to write the number sentence to match.

# Things I Like About Me

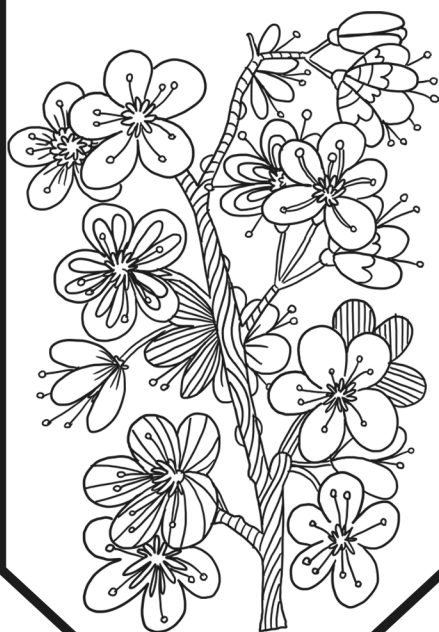
Mirror, mirror on the wall, who's the nicest child of all?

Can you write or draw as many things as you can that you like about yourself. For example, you might write: I like my hair; or I like my brown eyes; or I am funny.



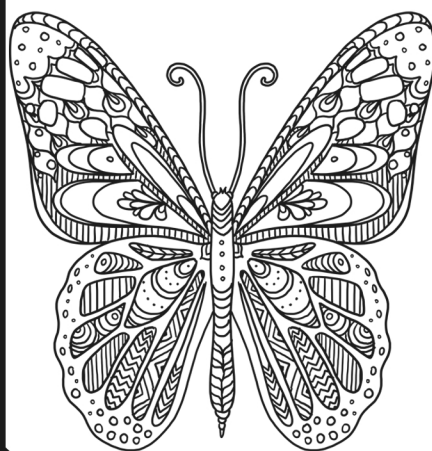


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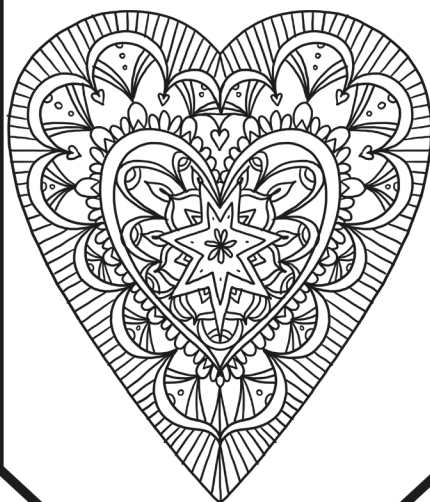
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
