<u>Maths</u>

For example half of 350= 175, a quarter of 200= 50, or three quarters of 600= 450, you could then make the questions more challenging, for example: 2/5 of 100, 3/8 of 1600

7/10 of 50.

Would you change any part of the story? How?

Would you change any of the characters? How?

Which part of the story was the funniest, saddest, scariest, saddest and happiest?
