

As writers we will be learning to:

- Write detailed instructions with clear introduction and conclusion.
- Talk in a series of debates on various subjects. Children will work in groups/ pairs/ individually to prepare and present points of views.
- Listen to, read and respond to raps.
- Experiment with writing their own.

As Mathematicians we will be consolidating our learning in all areas of maths, by working on multi-step problems and investigations. Children will be expected to understand which method to use to solve the problems.

As Scientists we will learn about the movement of the Earth and other planets relative to the sun.

We will describe the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth.

We will learn about the other planets in the solar system.
