Mapping the World

In Geography this half term we will be focusing on what maps can tell us about the world. We will also learn how to read an ordnance survey map.

English

Maths

Year 5

Year 6

Will use all their maths skills to solve investigations and number problems.

Science

We will learn about how we use electricity and how electrical circuits are made and drawn.

Religious Education

This half term we will be answering the question 'How do Hindu's make sense of the world?'

We will learn about their beliefs and how they celebrate their religion.
