In Science we will learn about forces and magnets. Here are some of the things we will be learning about throughout this half of the Summer term.

We will learn about biomes and climate, understanding that biomes are areas with similar climates and landscapes where specific plants and animals thrive. They explore how these biomes are influenced by climate, including factors like temperature, rainfall, and soil fertility.

English
