We will investigate who Alexander the great was and what the lasting achievements of the Greeks were.




English

Maths

Every day, the children will practice their number fluency through 'Number Ninjas' followed by a short weekly arithmetic quiz on a Friday. This half term we are working on our knowledge of decimals using money, properties of shape where we will identify angles and draw shapes and angles. We will describe position using coordinates. In statistics we will interpret bar charts and interpret line graphs.
