Red Nose Day

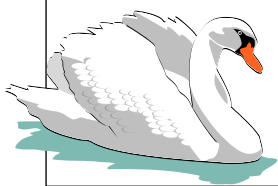
We enjoyed a superhero song from Cherry and Oak, jokes and dances from Willow, and variety performances from Rowan!

Thank you FOLS for gifting an Easter Egg to every pupil.

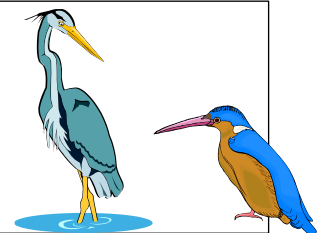


TEAM POINTS SHIELD
